Autumn 1 Theme – Inspirational people in today's world What can we learn from great leaders and inspiring examples in today's world? UC – Kingdom of God What kind of king is Jesus?	I can explain how inspirational leader are examples of their religions ideals			
	I can connect two examples explaining what they have in common.			
	I can consider and explain what makes a leader inspiring			
	I can explain what inspiration means to me and reflect upon the need for role models			
Autumn 2 Incarnation Was Jesus the Messiah?	I can explain that Jesus was Jewish, that Christians believe Jesus id god in the flesh and that he is part of gods plan to restore his relationship with humans			
	I can talk about where/how in the bible the messiah is described and that Christians believe Jesus is that messiah and their saviour			
	I can explain hoe Christians put their beliefs about Jesus' incarnation into practice at Christmas			
	I can weigh up haw far the idea that Jesus is the messiah is important in the world today			
Spring 1 Theme- Religion and the individual: what matters for Christians? What is expected of a person in following a religion or belief? What matters most to Christians in their religion? UC-Gospel what would Jesus do?	I can explain three or more Christian beliefs and explain what matters to Christians			
	I can explain with reasons why they select one of the four elements of Christianity as the most important			
	I can explain what matters about worshipping God to Christians			
	I can explain the similarities and differences between different celebrations in Christian worship			
Spring 2 Salvation What did Jesus do to save Human Beings?	I can explain how incarnation and salvation fit in the bible timeline and what it means when we say Jesus' death was a sacrifice			
	I can suggest meanings for narratives of Jesus death/resurrection, comparing the ways these texts are interpreted			
	I can make connections between the Christian belief in Jesus' death as a sacrifice and how Holy communion is celebrated			
	I can show how Christians put their beliefs into practice and weigh up the value and impact of ideas of sacrifice in our own lives today			
Summer 1 Theme- Beliefs and questions How do people's beliefs about God, the world and others have impact on their lives?	I can explain the main beliefs of Muslims and Hindus about God			
	I can show that I understand why the worship of Allah/Brahman matters to Muslims and Hindus			
	I can consider different answers as to whether God is real or not and express my own thoughts and reflections			
	I can explain what matters about worshipping God to Muslims			
	I can explain what matters about worshipping Gods and Goddesses to Hindus			
Summer 2 Theme- Beliefs and actions in the world How are religious and spiritual thoughts and beliefs expressed in arts and architecture and in charity and generosity.	I can explain beliefs about the value of scared spaces to believers in at least two religions			
	I can explain the tension between building a beautiful house for God and serving people in poverty			
	I can explain my own thoughts about the value of worship/holy buildings and charity/compassion and explain reasons why people might believe that worship makes them more charitable			
	I can explain what matters to different religions about worship and about generosity or charity
