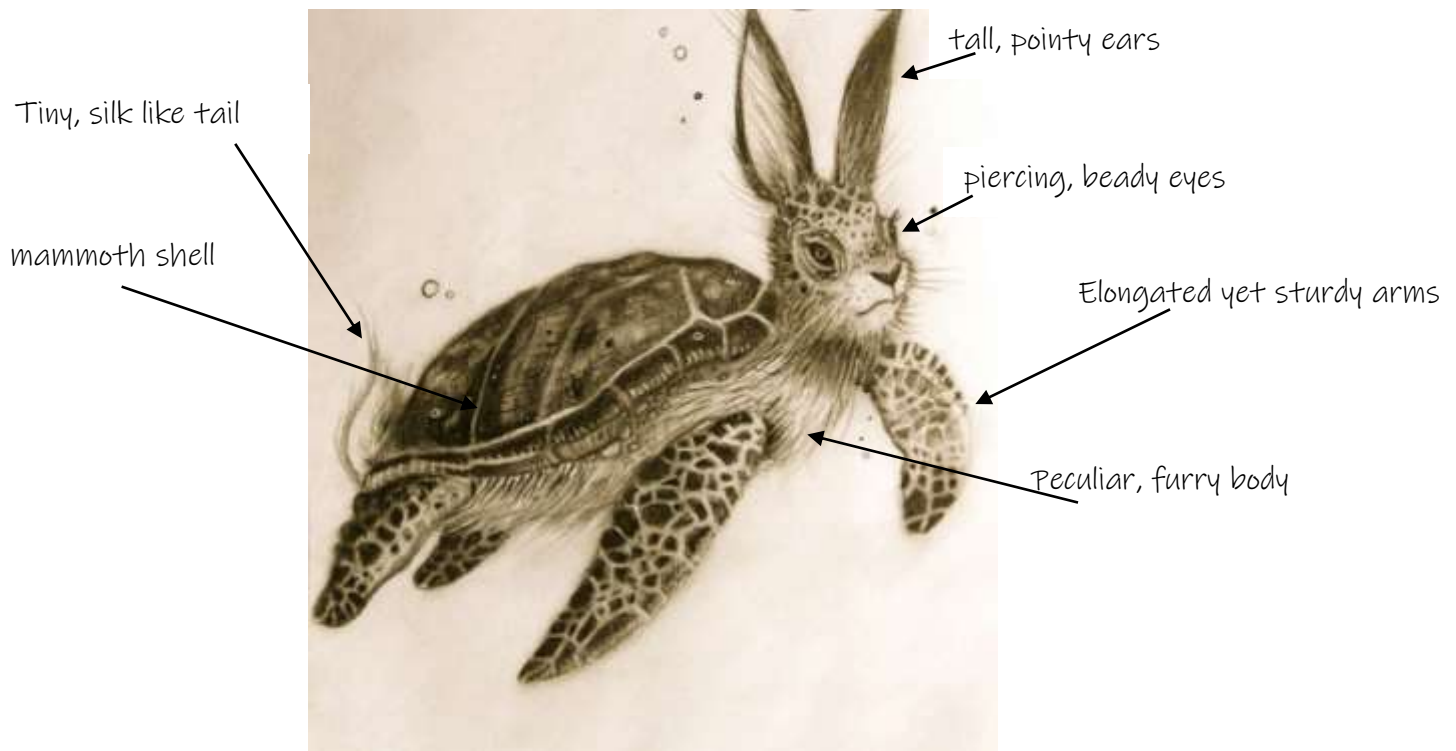




The Rabturtle
