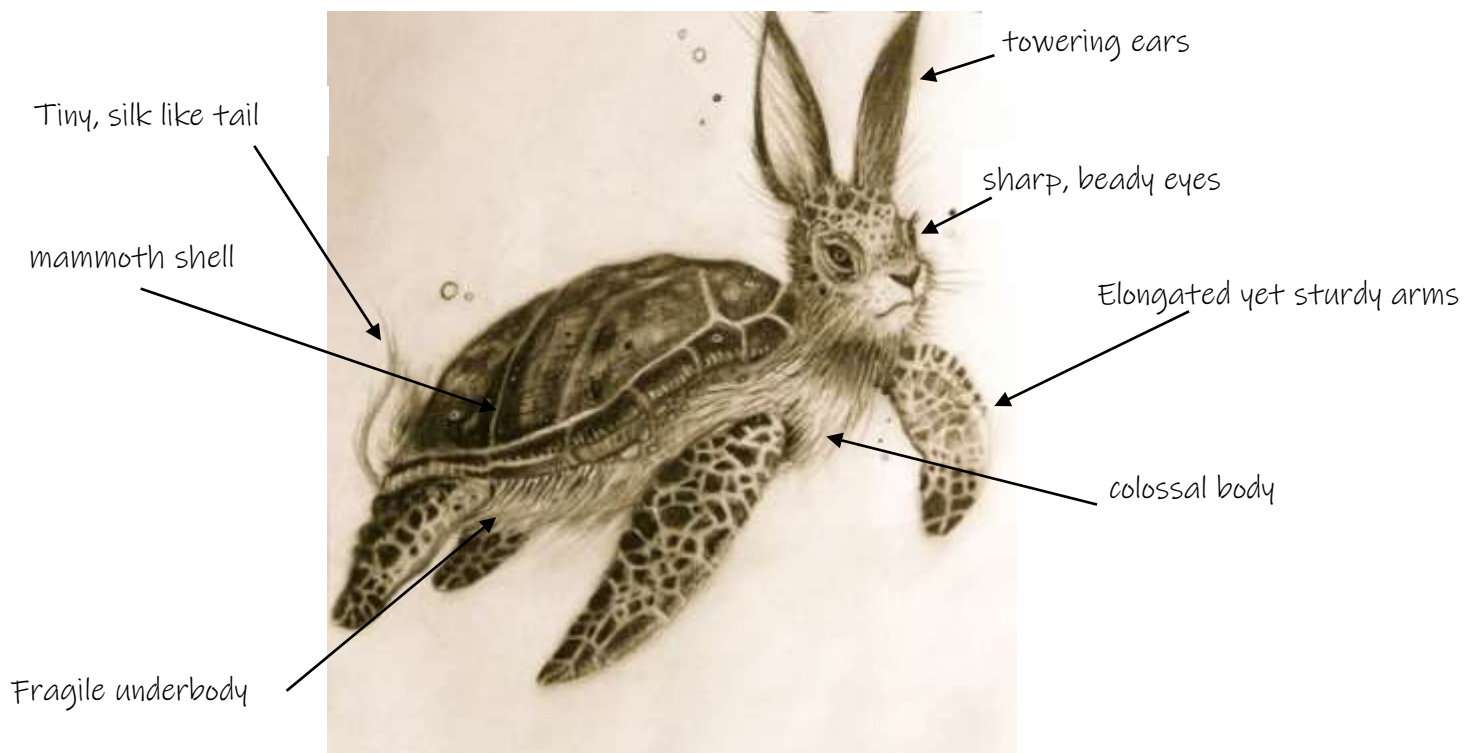




The Rabturtle
