Read Write Inc. Phonics

Reception children will be starting their daily phonics sessions in school this week.

Phonics is a way of teaching children how to read and write. It helps children hear, identify and use different sounds in words. The phonics scheme that we follow at school is Read Write inc. We will be holding a short phonics workshop for parents on **Tuesday 16th September at 3.20pm** to help you to support your child at home with early reading and writing – details to follow!

Which people are special and why?

We will look at the children's own unique gifts and talents, families, people who help us and identify some of the qualities of a good friend look at stories about Jesus as a friend to others recall and talk about stories of Jesus as a friend to others. □

Literacy

Our focus this half term will be looking closely at rhyme through nursery rhymes, other poems and stories. In addition, we will of course be starting our phonics sessions, not only the letter sounds but also letter formation and how we put them together to read and write words

PSHE – Our focus for this half term will be me and my relationships - looking at what makes us special.

Label everything!

Please make sure that your child's clothing and belongings are labelled, it really makes life a lot easier!

Reminder

This half term the children will complete the statutory baseline assessment. This is nothing to worry about and as far as the children are concerned all they will be aware of is that they have played a few games on an iPad!

Additional Snack

The children are all offered a piece of fruit each day at snack time. If you feel your child would like an additional healthy snack they can bring this in their book bag to eat at play time. Suitable snacks might include – cheese, fruit, cereal bars (no nuts please).

Expressive Arts and Design

This half term we will look at drawing faces and people and making self-portraits using a variety of media. We will create some seasonal art around autumn and harvest including leaf printing, vegetable faces link to the artist Giuseppe Arcimboldi and making soup. In music we will be exploring how we can make different sounds with our voices and bodies and experimenting with tempo and dynamics when playing instruments.
